The Small Grant Programme in Indonesia

(SGP Indonesia) is a collaborative program between the ASEAN Center for Biodiversity (ACB) and the Government of Indonesia through the Ministry of Environment and Forestry c.q. Directorate General of Conservation of Natural Resources and Ecosystems in the form of a Small Grant Programme that includes biodiversity and livelihood conservation programs. This cooperation is contained in a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by KLHK c.q. The Directorate of Conservation of Natural Resources and Ecosystems together with the ACB Executive Director dated May 21, 2015 in Jakarta. Funding support for this program was obtained from the German Government through the German Financial Cooperation/ KfW (BMZ No. 2011 66545).

SGP Indonesia invites all CSOs in Indonesia to submit proposals for funding support in the form of Small Grants for Conservation Programs in the ASEAN Heritage Park (AHP) area of Indonesia, particularly in Gunung Leuser National Park (GLNP) and Way Kambas National Park (WKNP).

General Conditions for Eligibility of Grantees

SGP Indonesia will provide EUR 20,000 – 100,000 for small grants and EUR 5,000 for micro grants to local or national Civil Society Organizations in the form of Foundations/Societies or Universities/Research Institutions that have Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Directorate General of Conservation of Natural Resources and Ecosystems (Dirjen KSDAE), Ministry of Environment and Forestry (KLHK) or Cooperation Agreement with the Authorities of GLNP/ WKNP or Recommendation Letter from the Authorities of GLNP/WKNP during the Cooperation Letter submission process.

The Conservation Program will be the focus on **SGP Indonesia Cycle 1** with a total grant of EUR 500,000 given to civil society organizations working in the Gunung Leuser National Park and Way Kambas National Park which pass at each stage of the selection process.

The potential grantees (proponent) send the Expression of Interest and Concept Note Proposal to the Penabulu Foundation / Service Provider - SGP Indonesia, via email with a template that can be downloaded on the SGP Indonesia website.

Time and Procedure for Submitting Proposal

- Submission of Letter of Intent and Concept Proposal is submitted no later than September 23, 2019
- Writing and Submitting Proposal can be done on September 16 to October 5, 2019.
- Submitting proposal using the Program Management and Monitoring System (GraMMS) can be done by proponent/potential grantees and/or through a Coaching Clinic with the SGP Indonesia Team.
- Coaching Clinic participants are Civil Society Organizations that have sent a Letter of Interest and Concept Proposal, bringing a Full Proposal for consultation and inclusion in GraMMS.

- The results of the final selection proposal will be announced no later than the end of October 2019.
