



# Call for Proposal Small Grants Programme (SGP) INDONESIA

**Small Grant Program in Indonesia (SGP Indonesia)** is program of cooperation between the Government of Indonesia through the Ministry of Environment and Forestry (MoEF) and the ASEAN Centre for Biodiversity (ACB) in the form of the Small Grant Program which includes biodiversity conservation programs and livelihood. This cooperation is contained in the Mutual Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed by MoEF cq. ASOEN Chair Indonesia together with the ACB Executive Director dated 21 May 2015 in Jakarta with the Directorate of Biodiversity Conservation (KKH) as Project Implementing Agency (PIA), Directorate General of Natural Resource Conservation and Ecosystem (KSDAE). Funding support for this program was obtained from The German Government through German/KfW Financial Cooperation (BMZ No. 2011 66545).

SGP Indonesia through **Penabulu Grant Management - Penabulu Foundation** invited all Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) in Indonesia to submit proposals to support funding in the Small Grants for the Livelihood Improvement Program in the ASEAN Heritage Park (AHP) region of Indonesia, specifically in Gunung Leuser National Park (GLNP) and Way Kambas National Park (WKNP).

## General Conditions for Eligibility of Grant Recipients

SGP Indonesia will provide funding support at local or national Civil Society Organizations in the form of Foundations/Societies/Association/ or Universities/Research Institutions that have Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Directorate General of Conservation of Natural Resources and Ecosystems (Directorat General of KSDAE), Ministry of Environment and Forestry (MoEF) or Cooperation Agreement with the Authorities of GLNP/WKNP or Recommendation Letter from the Authorities of GLNP/WKNP during the Cooperation Letter submission process.

**The Livelihood Improvement Program** will be the focus of SGP Indonesia Cycle 2 with a total grant of EUR 1,000,000 given to Indonesian civil society organizations (local or national) that working in the Gunung Leuser National Park and Way Kambas National Park are escaped at each selection stages. - Full proposal sent to SGP Indonesia Sekretariat no later than 31 May 2020 at 11.59 pm (Jakarta time)
