To implement successful interventions covering both biodiversity and livelihood aspects in selected AHPs and adjacent areas



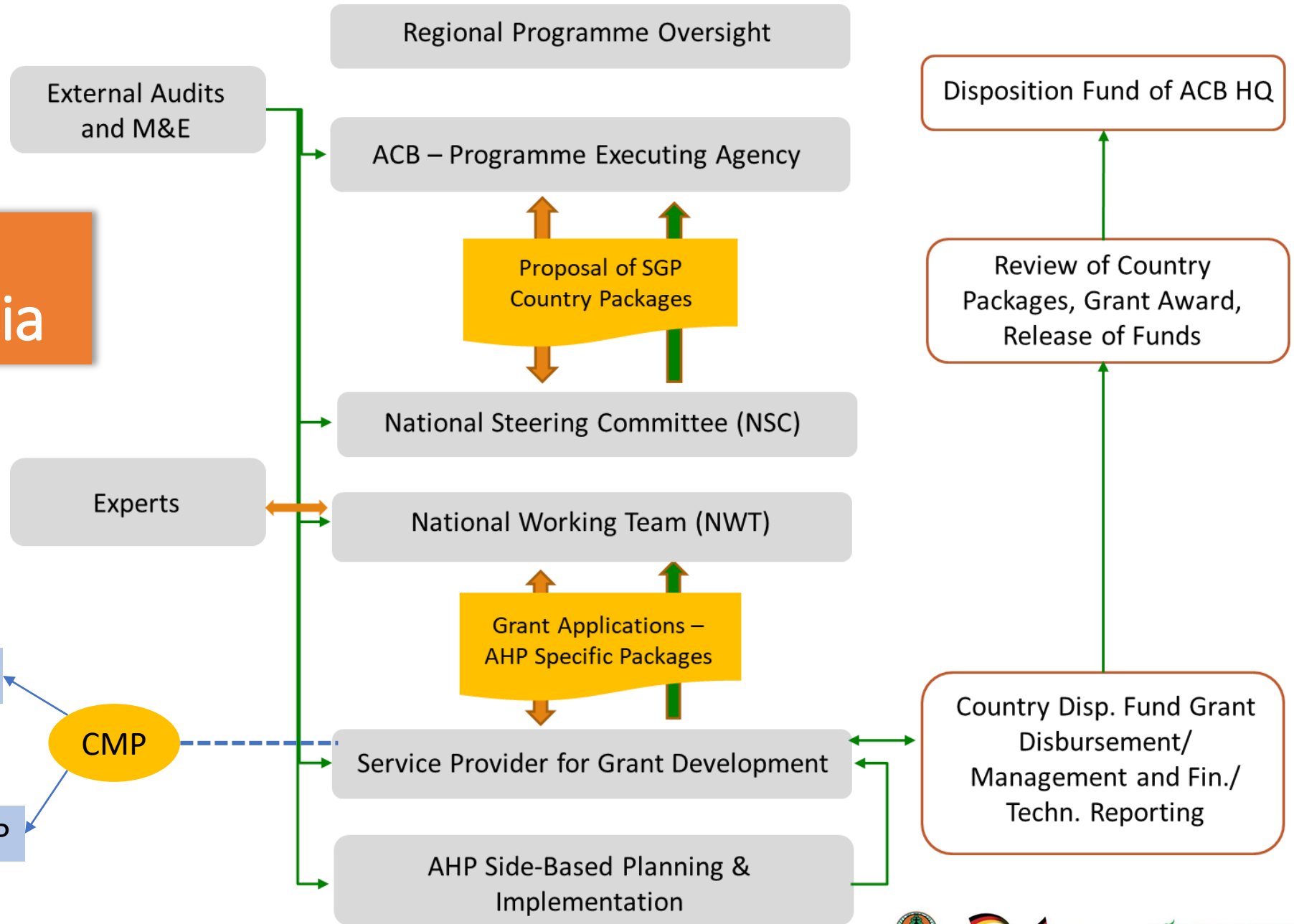
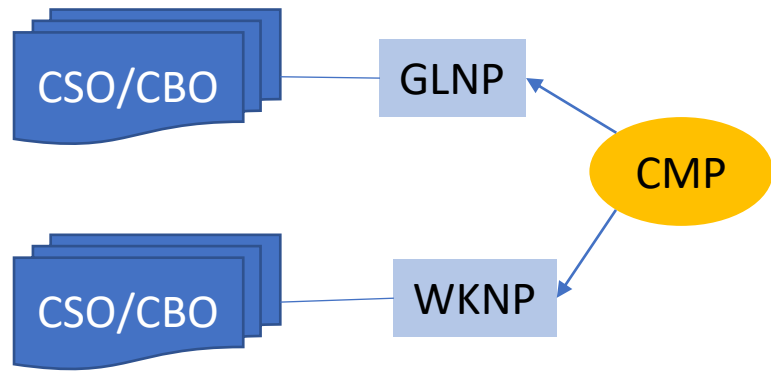
